Kansas City Parks and Recreation is developing a Master Plan for both Searcy Creek Greenway and Hidden Valley Park. Public spaces are the cornerstones of a vibrant and healthy community. They also serve as the backbone of what it means for Kansas City to be a "Green Community". Our parks, trails, and recreational facilities should expand as our community grows, but growth should be strategic and respond to community culture, important needs, and grassroots initiatives.

Via a 6-month long process, KC Parks and Rec and a planning team will engage community members in conversations about the future of both Searcy Creek Greenway and Hidden Valley Park. The outcome of the discussions and additional analysis will help generate improvement recommendations that will guide planning and design of both Searcy Creek Greenway and Hidden Valley Park.

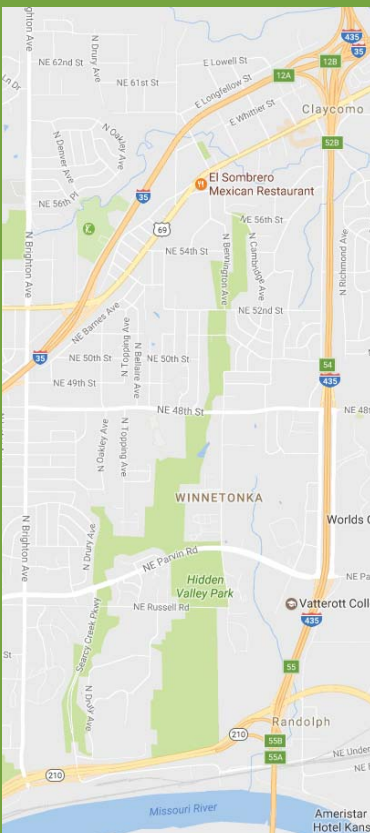
