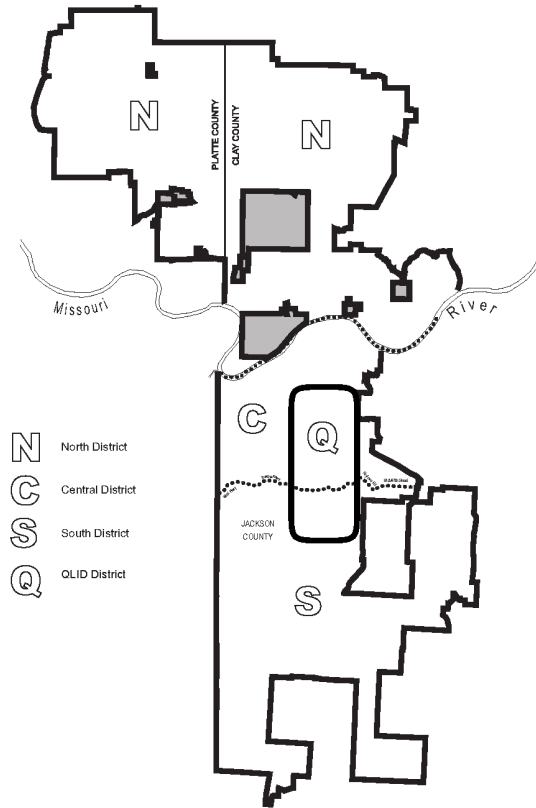

NO PERSON SHALL ERECT ANY SIGNBOARD OR POST OR DISPLAY ANY PERMANENT OR UNATTENDED PLACARD OR ADVERTISEMENT OF ANY KIND UPON OR ALONG ANY BOULEVARD, STREET, PARKWAY, PARK ROAD OR ELSEWHERE IN ANY PARK OR OTHER PUBLIC GROUNDS UNDER THE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF THE BOARD OF PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSIONERS.

Penalty provision: 1-17 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES/OFF- ROADING

70-1 ATV DEFINITION

ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE MANUFACTURED AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR OFF-HIGHWAY USE WHICH IS 50 INCHES OR LESS IN WIDTH, WITH AN UNLADEN DRY WEIGHT OF 600 POUNDS OR LESS, TRAVELING ON THREE, FOUR OR MORE LOW-PRESSURE TIRES, WITH A SEAT DESIGNATED TO BE STRADDLED BY THE OPERATOR AND HANDLEBARS FOR STEERING CONTROL.

70-749(a) OPERATE AN ATV OFF-ROAD

NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 70-1, UPON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS, PARKS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY OF THIS CITY.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (\$96)

70-749(c) OPERATE AN ATV WITHOUT LICENSE

A PERSON OPERATING AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ON A STREET OR HIGHWAY PURSUANT TO AN EXCEPTION COVERED IN THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE A VALID LICENSE, BUT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO HAVE PASSED AN EXAMINATION FOR THE OPERATION OF A MOTORCYCLE, AND THE VEHICLE SHALL BE OPERATED AT SPEED OF LESS THAN 30 MILES PER HOUR. WHEN OPERATED ON A STREET OR HIGHWAY, AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SHALL HAVE A BICYCLE SAFETY FLAG, WHICH EXTENDS NOT LESS THAN SEVEN FEET ABOVE THE GROUND, ATTACHED TO THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (\$106)

70-749(d)(1) OPERATE AN ATV CARELESSLY

NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE:

(1) IN ANY CARELESS WAY SO AS TO ENDANGER THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OF ANOTHER.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

70-749(d)(2) OPERATE AN ATV WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE

NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE:

(2) WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR ANY CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

ANIMALS

14-11 ANIMAL ABANDONMENT

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY OWNER OR KEEPER TO ABANDON ANY ANIMAL. THE TERM "TO ABANDON" INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO ANY INSTANCE WHERE THE OWNER OR KEEPER LEAVES AN ANIMAL WITHOUT DEMONSTRATED OR APPARENT INTENT TO RECOVER OR TO RESUME CUSTODY; OR LEAVES AN ANIMAL FOR MORE THAN 12 HOURS WITHOUT PROVIDING FOR ADEQUATE FOOD, WATER, AND SHELTER FOR THE DURATION OF THE ABSENCE; OR TURNS OUT OR RELEASES AN ANIMAL; OR DUMPS OR RELEASES AN ANIMAL FROM A VEHICLE.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

14-16.2 ANIMAL STRUCK BY MOTOR VEHICLE

THE OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH STRIKES ANY ANIMAL SHALL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE REPORT THE ACCIDENT TO THE CITY AT 816-513-1313.

Penalty provision: 14-51 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

14-17 INJURING, TRAPPING OR POISONING ANIMALS

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO DELIBERATELY INJURE OR KILL, CAPTURE OR TRAP, EXPOSE A POISONOUS SUBSTANCE FOR, OR POISON ANY ANIMAL; AND, FURTHER, IT SHALL BE AN UNLAWFUL ACT TO ATTEMPT ANY OF SUCH UNLAWFUL ACTS.

(a) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO LAWFUL TRAPPING OF WILDLIFE PURSUANT TO SECTION 50-271.

(b) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO ARCHERY HUNTING CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 50-268

Penalty provision: 14-51 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

14-20 LICENSE FOR DOGS AND CATS-REQUIRED

IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF EVERY PERSON OWNING, KEEPING OR HARBORING IN THE CITY ANY DOG, CAT OR FERRET OVER 120 DAYS OLD TO PROCURE A LICENSE THEREFORE FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF REVENUE OR HIS DISIGNEE. THE RECEIPT ISSUED FOR THE LICENSE SHALL CONSTITUTE A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY AND EVIDENCE OF LICENSURE FOR KEEPING OF SUCH DOG, CAT OR FERRET WITHIN THE CITY.

Penalty provision: 14-51

14-27 WEARING OF LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION TAG REQUIRED

NO OWNER OR KEEPER OF ANY DOG, CAT OR FERRET SHALL ALLOW OR PERMIT SUCH DOG, CAT OR FERRET TO BE OUTSIDE THE RESIDENCE OF THE OWNER OR KEEPER, WITHOUT HAVING ATTACHED TO A COLLAR ABOUT THE NECK OF SUCH ANIMAL OR TO A SECURE BODY HARNESS THE LICENSE TAG PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 14-16 OR THE IDENTIFICATION TAG PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 14-44.

Penalty provision: 14-51

14-33(a) ANIMALS (RUNNING AT LARGE)

DID (AS OWNER, KEEPER, OR HARBORER OF A DOG) ALLOW THE DOG TO RUN AT LARGE, EXCLUDING ANY PERSON PERMITTING OR ALLOWING A DOG TO RUN AT LARGE WITHIN AN "OFF-LEASH AREA" ESTABLISHED ON PARKS UNDER THE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF THE BOARD OF PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSIONERS

Penalty provision: 14-51 (\$96)

14-37 ANIMALS (DISPOSAL OF DEAD ANIMALS)

NO PERSON SHALL POSSESS A CARCASS OF AN ANIMAL NOT TO BE USED FOR FOOD UPON ANY STREET, SIDEWALK, PARK, PUBLIC GROUND, PRIVATE LOT UNLESS PLACED FOR PICKUP AFTER HAVING GIVEN NOTICE TO THE CITY.

Penalty provision: 1-17

14-48 RESCUE OF ANIMALS LEFT IN VEHICLE UNDER DANGEROUS WEATHER CONDITIONS

WHENEVER ANY ANIMAL IS FOUND CONFINED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A PUBLIC PLACE UNDER WEATHER CONDITIONS THAT ENDANGER ITS LIFE AS DETERMINED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ANIMAL HEALTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY (SUPERVISOR) OR POLICE, THE SUPERVISOR OR POLICE ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ENTER SUCH VEHICLE AND RESCUE SUCH ANIMAL AND THEREAFTER

Penalty provision: 1-17

ARROWS

50-266(C) ARROWS

(c) THE USE OF BOWS AND TARGET ARROWS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY SHALL BE IN SUCH A MANNER AS NOT TO ENDANGER THE LIFE, LIMB OR PROPERTY OF OTHERS. BOWS AND TARGET ARROWS SHALL BE USED ON CITY PARK PROPERTY ONLY IN AREAS PROVIDED OR INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC RECREATING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

Penalty provision 1-17 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

50-268 ARCHERY HUNTING

NO ARCHERY HUNTING SHALL BE ALLOWED WITHIN 150 FEET OF ANY STRUCTURE USED OR DESIGNED FOR NON-AGRICULTURAL, COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL OR PUBLIC PURPOSES, OR OF ANY PIECE OF LAND USED OR DESIGNED FOR USE AS A PUBLIC PARK OR OF ANY ROAD.

BIKES/ BICYCLES

70-688 EXCESS RIDERS ON BIKE

NO BICYCLE SHALL BE USED TO CARRY MORE PERSONS AT ONE TIME THAN THE NUMBER FOR WHICH IT IS DESIGNED OR EQUIPPED, EXCEPT THAT AN ADULT RIDER MAY CARRY A CHILD SECURELY ATTACHED TO HIS PERSON IN A BACKPACK OR SLING.

Penalty provisions 70-101 (\$61)

70-690(a) RIDING BICYCLE OR MOPED ON ROADWAY

(a) ANY PERSON OPERATION A BICYCLE OR A MOPED UPON A ROADWAY AT LESS THAN THE NORMAL SPEED OF TRAFFIC AT THE TIME AND PLACE AND UNDER THE CONDITIONS THEN EXISTING SHALL RIDE AS SLOW AS PRACTICABLE TO THE RIGHTHAND CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY EXCEPT UNDER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

- (1) WHEN OVERTAKING AND PASSING ANOTHER BICYCLE OR VEHICLE PROCEEDING IN THE SAME DIRECTION.
- (2) WHEN PREPARING FOR A LEFT TURN AT THE INTERSECTION OR INTO A PRIVATE ROAD OR DRIVEWAY.
- (3) WHEN REASONABLY NECESSARY TO AVOID CONDITIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FIXED OR MOVING OBJECTS, PARKED OR MOVING VEHICLES, BICYCLES, PEDESTRIANS, ANIMALS, SURFACE HAZARDS OR SUBSTANDARD WIDTH LANES THAT MAKE IT UNSAFE TO CONTINUE ALONG THE RIGHTHAND CURB OR EDGE. FOR PUPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A SUBSTANDARD WIDTH LANE IS A LANE THAT IS TOO NARROW FOR A BICYCLE AND A VEHICLE TO TRAVEL SAFELY SIDE BY SIDE WITHIN THE LANE.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-691(b) FAIL USE AVAIL BIKE PATH

(b) WHEREVER A USABLE PATH FOR BICYCLES HAS BEEN PROVIDED ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY, BICYCLE RIDERS SHALL USE SUCH PATH AND SHALL NOT USE THE ROADWAY.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-692 BICYCLIST CARRYING ITEMS

NO PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE SHALL CARRY ANY PACKAGE, BUNDLE OR ARTICLE WHICH PREVENTS THE USE OF BOTH HANDS IN THE CONTROL AND OPERATION OF THE BICYCLE. A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE SHALL KEEP AT LEAST ONE HAND ON THE HANDLEBARS AT ALL TIMES.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-695(a) BIKE YIELD PED ON SIDEWALK

DID OPERATE (VELOCIPEDE, BICYCLE, TRICYCLE, WHEELBARROW, HANDCART OR OTHER VEHICLE) UPON SIDEWALKS, CURBSTONES, GRASS PLOTS OR PLANTING SPACE OF ANY PARK, BOULEVARD, PARK-WAY, AVENUE, STREET OR PARK ROAD.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-695(b) BIKE PROHIBITED – SIDEWALK

(a) A PERSON SHALL NOT RIDE A BICYCLE UPON AND ALONG A SIDEWALK, OR ACROSS A ROADWAY UPON AND ALONG A CROSSWALK, WHERE SUCH USE OF BICYCLES IS PROHIBITED BY OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-696 BICYCLE PARKING

(a) A PERSON MAY PARK A BICYCLE ON A SIDEWALK UNLESS PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY AN OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE,

(b) A BICYLCE PARKED ON A SIDEWLAK SHALL NOT IMPEDE THE NORMAL AND REASONABLE MOVEMENT OF PEDESTRIAN OR OTHER TRAFFIC.

(c) A BICYCLE MAY BE PARKED ON THE ROADWAY AT ANY ANGLE TO THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY AT ANY LOCAITON WHERE PARKING IS ALLOWED.

(d) A BICYCLE MAY BE PARKED ON THE ROADWAY ABREAST OF ANOTHER BICYCLE OR BICYCLES NEAR THE SIDE OF THE ROADWAY AT ANY LOCATION WHERE PARKING IS ALLOWED.

(e) A PERSON SHALL NOT PARK A BICYCLE ON A ROADWAY IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO OBSTRUCT THE MOVEMENT OF A LEGALLY PARKED MOTOR VEHICLE.

(f) IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, BICYCLES PARKED ANYWHERE ON A STREET OR HIGHWAY SHALL CONFORM WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE V OF THIS CHAPTER REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

70-699-701 LIGHTS ON BICYCLES

EVERY BICYCLE IN USE FROM ONE-HALF HOUR AFTER SUNSET TO ONE HALF-HOUR BEFORE SUNRISE, AND AT OTHER TIME WHEN, DUE TO INSUFFICIENT LIGHT OR UNFAVORABLE ATMOSPHERIC CONDITIONS, BICYCLES AND THEIR RIDERS ARE NOT DISCERNABLE AT A DISTANCE OF 1,000 FEET SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A LAMP ON THE FRONT EMITTING A WHITE LIGHT VISIBLE FROM A DISTANCE OF AT LEAST 500 FEET TO THE FRONT, AS WELL AS REFLECTIVE MATERIAL OR LIGHTED LAMPS THAT ARE VISIBLE FROM THE SIDES OF OTHE BICYCLE.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$61)

EVERY BICYCLE SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A RED REFLECTOR OF A TYPE WHICH SHALL BE VISIBLE FOR 600 FEET TO THE REAR.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

64-10 BOTTLES AND GLASS

NO ONE SHALL TAKE, THROW, PLACE (OR CAUSE TO BE TAKEN, THROWN, OR PLACED) A GLASS BEVERAGE BOTTLES IN OR UPON ANY PARK, RECREATIONAL FACILITY, OR PUBLIC GROUNDS.

Penalty provision 1-17 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

50-152 CONSUME ALCOHOL

NO ONE SHALL CONSUME INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON A PUBLIC (STREET, SIDEWALK, or PARK) WITHOUT APPROVAL OF PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

Penalty provision 1-17 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

CURFEW

50-237 CURFEW

NO MINOR MAY LOITER, WANDER, STROLL OR PLAY IN OR UPON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS, ROADS, ALLEYS, PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES UNSUPERVISED BY AN ADULT WHO HAS THE LAWFUL AUTHORITY TO BE AT SUCH PLACES BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11 P.M. - 6 A.M. (WEEKDAYS) AND 12 A.M. - 6 A.M. (WEEKENDS).

DISTURBANCE

46-5(3) NOISE DISTURB SOUND SYSTEM

SELF-CONTAINED, PORTABLE, NON-VEHICULAR MUSIC OR SOUND PRODUCTION OR AMPLIFICATION DEVICES SHALL NOT BE OPERATED ON A PUBLIC SPACE OR PUBLIC RIGHT- OF-WAY AS TO BE PLAINLY AUDIBLE AT A DISTANCE OF 50 FEET IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THE OPERATOR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7 A.M. - 10 P.M. BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10 P.M. - 7 A.M., SOUND FROM SUCH EQUIPMENT, OPERATED ON A PUBLIC SPACE, SHALL NOT BE PLAINLY AUDIBLE BY ANY PERSON OTHER THAN THE OPERATOR.

Penalty provision 46-39 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

46-5(7)(A) LOUD MUSIC VEHICLE 8 A.M. TO 10 P.M.

VEHICULAR MUSIC AMPLIFICATION OR REPRODUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT BE OPERATED IN SUCH A MANNER THAT IS PLAINLY AUDIBLE AT A DISTANCE OF 50 FEET IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THE OPERATOR OR SOUND SOURCE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 AM – 10PM.

Penalty provision 46-39 (\$96)

46-5(7)(B) LOUD MUSIC VEHICLE 10 P.M. TO 8 A.M.

VEHICULAR MUSIC AMPLIFICATION OR REPRODUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT BE OPERTATED IN SUCH A MANNER THAT IT IS PLAINLY AUDIBLE AT A DISTANCE OF 25 FEET IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THE OPERATOR OR SOUND SOURCE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10 P.M. - 8 A.M.

Penalty provision 46-39 (\$96)

DRIVING ON SIDEWALK/ TRAIL/ BAKE LANE

70-523 DRIVE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY – SIDEWALK / TRAIL

NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE ANY VEHICILE OTHER THAN BY HUMAN POWER UPON A SIDEWALK, SIDEWALK AREA, PARK, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, EXCEPT UPON A PERMANENT OR DULY AUTHORIZED TEMPORARY DRIVEWAY.

Penalty provision 70-101 (\$106)

DUMPING

62-89 ILLEGAL DUMPING

NO PERSON SHALL DUMP OR OTHERWISE DEPOSIT OR CAUSE, PERMIT, SUFFER, OR ALLOW THE DUMPING OR DEPOSITING OF ANY GARBAGE, RUBBISH, YARD WASTE, LITTER, OR ANY OTHER OFFENSIVE OR DISAGREEABLE THING IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE, PUBLIC BUILDING, OR MARKET, OR ON OR ALONG ANY SIDEWALK, STREET, ALLEY, BOULEVARD, HIGHWAY, RIGHT-OF- WAY, VIADUCT, TUNNEL, PARK OR PARKWAY, OR UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY OR IN ANY REFUSE CONTAINER LOCATED THEREON WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY, NOR SHALL ANY PERSON DUMP OR DEPOSIT OR CAUSE, PERMIT, SUFFER OR ALLOW THE DUMPING OR DEPOSITING OF GARBAGE OR HOUSEHOLD REFUSE IN ANY CITY LITTER CAN OR BASKET UPON ANY STREET.

Penalty provision 62-89(c) (Mandatory Court Appearance)

64- 9 DUMPING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

(a) NO PERSON SHALL DUMP OR DEPOSIT, OR CAUSE TO BE DEPOSITED OR DUMPED, ON ANY PUBLIC PROPERTY OR STREET OF THE CITY, ANY DIRT, EARTH, ROCK, CLAY, SAND, SHALE, BUILDING MATERIAL, DEBRIS OR RUBBISH, OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL, EXCEPT UNDER PERMIT BY THE CITY.

Penalty provision 1-17 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

EXCAVATION

64-114 EXCAVATE WITHOUT A PERMIT

NO PERSON SHALL MAKE OR CAUSE TO BE MADE ANY EXCAVATION IN ANY PROPERTY, RIGHT-OF-WAY OR EASEMENTS OWNED BY THE CITY OR UNDER THE CONTROL AND SUPERVISION OF THE BOARD OF PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSIONERS, UNLESS THE PERSON COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS ARTICLE AND IN ADDITION APPLIES FOR AND OBTAINS A PERMIT FOR THE EXCAVATION FROM THE BOARD OF PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSIONERS.

Penalty provision 64-131 (Mandatory Court Appearance)

FIREWORKS

26-5608.16.1(a) PROHIBITION OF FIREWORKS

(a) EXCEPT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO POSSESS, KEEP, STORE, OFFER FOR SALE, EXPOSE FOR SALE, SELL AT RETAIL, USE, OR EXPLODE ANY FIREWORKS IN THE CITY.

SWIMMING OR WADING IN FOUNTAINS

50-202(A) PROHIBITION SWIMMING OR WADING
